

## The Venue

ADANAC CYC is situated on 13 acres of undulating parkland, manicured gardens, natural bush, a recreational lake, with magnificent views over the Yarra Ranges - and only an hour east of Melbourne's CBD in the beautiful Yarra Valley.

Accommodation areas are easily accessible to and closely situated around the dining and function rooms. Each couple or family will be allocated their own room, most with en-suite bathroom. Similarly singles pending numbers. Guests supply their own personal bedding and towels although pillows are provided.



## The Program

Our camp program offers both fun activities and supportive sessions, with all ages, interests and abilities catered for, including those who just want to chill out and relax.

The program has been developed with input from our Treatment Centres, HFV members and families, as well as experts in Adventure Therapy. For young families the extended morning treatment session overseen by Janine from the RCH is a favourite. Also early morning walks, relaxation/yoga, secret men's and secret women's business and for the adventurous a water slide, canoes, stand-up paddleboard, flying fox, water trampoline and much more.

**EVENINGS:** On both Friday and Saturday evening there are activities for all the family. If you are unable to make it for dinner on Friday, it would be great if you can make it by 7pm in time for the official welcome followed by assorted activities to help us all ease into camp life and get to know one another better, especially those who have not been to our camp before.

## The Team

You will be in safe hands! Activities are led by trained CYC and \*Purple Soup staff, ably supported by our growing band of



emerging HFV Youth Leaders. Not only do our youth provide great support during activities, they are also wonderful role models with a wealth of knowledge and personal experiences they will happily share with younger children and parents.

## Cost

HFV acknowledges the support of HFA in securing a grant to part fund the camp and help us to heavily subsidise camp fees for HFV members. The camp fees are detailed below.
